From Puerto de la Cruz on the TF-5 about 14 km to the traffic circle where the TF-5 forks. We take the exit onto the coastal highway and drive to Icod at the end of the highway (another 5.3 km). Now we take the TF-42 and drive to Buenavista del Norte (another 14.7 km). From here, continue on the TF-445 to the bridge over "our" stream with the large water tank next to it (2.5 km from the exit of the TF-42). Park our (possibly lower) car here. If you can and want to move with 2 cars (so at <http://www.descente-canyon.com/canyoning/canyon/22540/La-Torre.html> ), take the second one up to the Camino (hiking trail) le Torre, see map "Parking lot access".
