Summary: (machine translated) Also known as Barranco del Diablo or Barranco del Boròn. It is a dry canyon with water only after heavy rains, long and hard access, somewhat tiring descent because it is not too continuous and fairly simple return. Good views in its access, many rappels destrepables and some surprise in the descent, even so it is remaining for collectors. Prohibited between December and June due to nesting.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) We must be located in Vadiello near Santa Eulalia la Mayor. For it by the N240 towards Lleida we will go to Loporzano. From here to Sasa de Abadiado by the HU330 and here we continue to Castilsabás and we will continue almost to the reservoir of Vadiello, in the closed curve to the right we have place to park on the left in the parking lot of the via ferrata del Palomo. We can also continue along the road almost to the reservoir and park in the parking lot behind the tunnel.		
Approach: (machine translated) By the return path of the ferrata if we have parked in the parking lot or the marked path from the parking lot of Vadiello begin to climb leaving the return to one side and getting into the hill of the mallos. We will continue along the grassy channel of the cliff until we reach a small climb where there is usually a rope to help, we will reach the top. We will continue along a more or less marked path passing under the Mallo de San Jorge where we will leave the access to the channels of O Ciego to one side and soon we will have the access to Lazas but we will continue climbing almost to the Peña Liguerra where we will go to the right along the rocky area of the cirque in search of the riverbed and the first installation.		
Tour: (machine translated) Little continuous although with good rappels, if we are lucky enough to take it with water some waterfall can surprise us.		
Return: (machine translated) We will reach the path that leads us to the road.

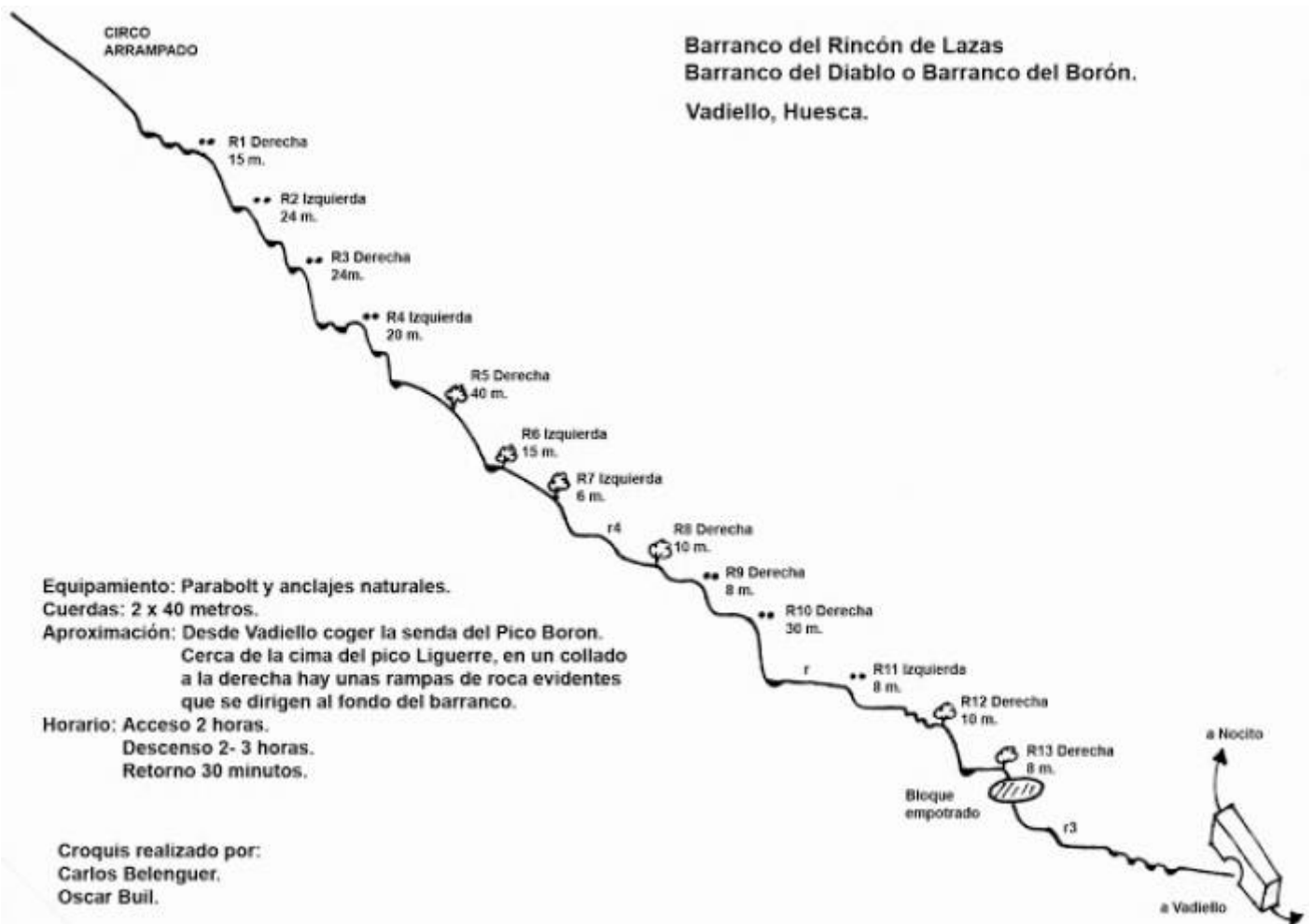
Automatisch importiert von Descente-Canyon.com für Canyon Rincón de Lazas Canyon déjà parcouru il y a 15 ans, refait cette année: 3 heures d'approche (même si la prochaine fois nous ne mettrons que 2h). Le départ se prend aux nouveaux escaliers en bétons situés juste à proximité de la maison de gestion du barrage. Le passage dans les buis, au pied du monolithe est sportif: il faut vraiment les mains. Il faut bien aller tout en haut du sommet en allant tout droit après les buis. Une fois au sommet, la vue est fabuleuse et on redescend légèrement et on s'engage dans le talweg à droite. Le départ n'est pas marqué, on progresse à pieds en s'engageant dans la pente sur 100 à 150 m de conglomérat, puis on trouve un premier relais mono point qui annonce le départ. Les relais ne sont pas souvent évidents. On a utilisé des buis à plusieurs reprises non équipés. Les relais sont vieillissants. La descente nous a pris 8h à 4 expérimentés mais en étant très prudents à chaque obstacle. Le retour: nous avons découvert un pont piéton en bois et rambarde en fer avant la fin et un sentier à droite et à gauche. Nous avons choisi de poursuivre la descente en l'absence d'indication. Nous avons fini au lac, et avons dû traverser 50m à la nage pour aller sur une rive qui était praticable et qui nous a permis de retrouver le sentier du retour. Probablement celui qui venait du pont en bois ! ? Cette course vaut le coup pour ceux qui aiment les rappels ! On a adoré !
