Summary: (machine translated) rappel canyon

Access: (machine translated) From Bregenz via Alberschwende, Mellau, Au, Schoppenau to Schröcken. After the first tunnel, take a sharp left. There is space where you can park the car. Continue with a second vehicle in the direction of Warth. After you have crossed the Seebach several times, you will come to a hotel with a canyoning provider (Strolz Aktiv; Haus Strolz - Nesslegg 94)) on the left side. Here you can park the upper car after prior request.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot about 50 m upstream along the stream to the bridge. Here is the entry.		
Tour: (machine translated) First Bachlatscher, then rappel with increasing height. The core point is the last waterfall of 40 m height, which should possibly be skipped when there is a lot of water, as crossing the rapel is unavoidable. Emergency exit orographic left before the final waterfall.		
Return: (machine translated) After the 40 m waterfall downstream , right out to the bridge and then right again to the car.

A great stream for in between with some small slides and rappels in or through the water jet, but there are also many "dry rappels" to avoid. We parked at the bottom and took the bus up (Schröcken Dorf -> Schröcken Alpenblick approx. 1.90€ p.p. as of 12.2025) The stands are mixed but mostly good. There are many rope belays, which are passable but all have to be checked, as some walk into the void or are loose). At rappel no. 4 you can simply get off (or on if you only want to do the two high rappels) (Schmitte bus stop). Here the intermediate belaystation is turned over (see picture), so rappel all the way down. The high rappel (No.2) can be reached Orog.Re. with a glued steel rope. Here Orog.Li. is still a steel cable (probably emergency exit or rappel outside the water jet) but this is no longer trustworthy as an express anchor is already hanging freely in the steel cable.
