<b>Gear:</b>		
<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Very vertical; often exposed belays; arrival pool not deep, usually little water; limestone; some sharp edges; more for smaller groups; nice view; accurate weather check; water can come and go very quickly!		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Torbole, drive up towards Val di Ledro and past the lake. After a few serpentines downhill at km 47 (on the SS 240, 3km before Storo), park the first car (here you can already see the last rappel and the water level). Take the second car in the direction of Storo. In Storo, follow the main road as far as the "SAV" DIY store. Turn right immediately after the DIY store and follow the narrow, straight road. Turn right at the small signs with the inscription "Via Trento". Follow the mountain road for approx. 3.6 km (you go through a tunnel and past a few houses). At the highest point you will come to a pilgrimage chapel. The road now leads slightly downhill. After a short stretch with a few bends, there is a sharp left-hand bend where a forest road (old "Privato" no-driving sign) branches off to the right. Follow the forest road downhill to the right (approx. 40m). At the first bend there is limited parking (max. two cars) (840m).		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the small parking possibility (right bend) follow the forest path to the left. Passing a house with a well, the path leads shortly to the stream (entry at about 830Hm).		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Very beautiful, open, south-facing canyon. Several short to medium rappels, with some exposed stands (rope traverses possible). You should be careful on the abseils because of the sharp edges. The rappels are mostly in the water, but the arrival pools are not deep. There are only short walking passages, if any, between the steps. The highest abseils are in the middle section of the tour. The Rio Val flows into the Palvico. The combination of the two rather short streams is recommended.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) The exit is directly on the road next to the stream Palvico (parking shuttle car) (830Hm).

If you get on at around 11.30/12.00, you will have sun throughout. The walk from the Palvico exit parking lot takes about 1.5 hours. (machine translated)

Nice vertical canyon for practicing, we didn't need any rope traverses at the water level. Before you reach the first anchor with a badge on the right, you have to downclimb about 5 steps. Be careful of vehicle height on the approach. We counted 13 rappels, the highest of which was approx. 39m (machine translated)

The access road is free, if you don't have enough ground clearance for the shuttle car then park one bend further up before leaving the asphalt road at the exit. The stands are ok and very exposed in the middle - last vertical part of the canyon. It is advisable to build a rope traverse for each of two places and to have set up the previous stand. After the last rappel, you can decide to run out to the left to the road or also rappel down the wall and continue in the river bed. For the combination with Plavico, it is recommended to go to the road and walk 5-10 minutes to the Palvico start. (machine translated)
