Summary: (machine translated) Expedition canyon in no man's land between Pareis and Mortitx. Exits with a free-hanging 67m waterfall in the Mediterranean. Currently forbidden to enter due to the presence of the Ferretet frogs, which were thought to be extinct		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Inca on the MA2130 in the direction of Lluc. At the top of the mountain pass, take the MA10 and follow it to the left towards Soller. After 4.7 km we come to the Restaurant d'Escorca on the left. We park our car here.		
Approach: (machine translated) Descend via the normal path into the valley of the Torrent de Pareis, on the opposite slope immediately 200m up along cairns to an old stone house 'Quarter des Carabiners', from here descend through the Dissgrass into the streambed of the Torrent des Ferretets.

Return: (machine translated) The best way is by boat.
