Summary:

A very entertaining canyon that emerges from the water catchment area of Cima d'Asta, the mountain of the same name that towers over the valley at a height of 2847 m. The canyon develops above the Grigno Gorge, but unlike the previous one, the technical difficulties are never excessive, making it suitable for everyone, even the less experienced. Its water is crystal clear and torrential, nestled between the granite rocks of the Cima d'Asta massif,

Access:

Approach: from Camping Due Laghi, take the state road 5S47 della Valsugana in the direction of Padova and exit at Castelnuovo. Then follow the signs for Tesino - Passo Brocon. Continue on the SP 78 to Pieve Tesino until the junction for Val Malene, where you turn left near the Tamoil petrol station (which is on the left-hand side of the road). Continue for about 8.7 km, always keeping left, until you reach the parking lot of Malga Sorgazza in about 15 minutes.

Access: from the parking lot, take the path that leads down to the stream (not marked) and follow the signs towards Cima d'Asta, after about 5 minutes you will reach the first abseil point of the canyon

Exit: after the last rappel of 35 m, ascend on foot along the right bank. After about 15 minutes you hairpin bend back to the Malga Sorgazza parking lot
