Resumen: (traducción alternativa) The upper part is also attractive, but more open and technically not as demanding as the lower part.		
Hidrología:		
Acceso: (traducción alternativa) Coming from Ivrea or Turin we approach the valley of Torrente Orco. On the SP460 past Cuorgne and Pont Canavese we drive up the Orco valley to Noasca (about 25 km from Pont Canavese - see also map in photo gallery). In the center of the village we find a parking place for our car. For transfer possibilities see http://www.gulliver.it/itinerario/52609/		
Acceso: (traducción alternativa) First, as for the ascent of the lower part: we take the trail that starts at the church (1055m altitude) and also leads to the final waterfall of the Noaschetta. However, before reaching the waterfall we turn right and climb on ribbons through the rock walls up to Alpe Sengie (1300m altitude). We take the path that passes below the houses and heads towards the stream. we cross on the footbridge to the orographic right bank and we continue to climb northwards along the path that we now meet towards Rifugio Noaschetta, located a few meters above the mentioned channel. We arrive at the houses of Borgà Sassa (1350m altitude). From here we continue climbing to Alpe Pian Sengio (1520m altitude). Here we enter the open and almost horizontal scree bed of the stream. From the Case Sengie, according to the map, an access also seems possible continuously on the orographic left side of the stream, see map - dotted line. Recorrido: (traducción alternativa) About 7 rappel, slide and possible jumps. At the latest when you reach the footbridge, where the entry to the lower part takes place, you can get off or join the ascent of the lower part.		
Regreso: (traducción alternativa) In the case of an exit left over the Case Sengie down the path to Noasca. In case of realization of the transfer and access alternatives to http://www.gulliver.it/itinerario/52609/ see there.
