Resumen: (traducción alternativa) A short canyon with very steep, deeply incised sections and beautiful individual spots.		
Hidrología:		
Acceso: (traducción alternativa) From Vancouver, take Highway 99 toward Whistler. At Exit 4 onto Woodgreen Dr., turn right toward Headland Dr. After about 400 meters, turn right into the parking lot.		
Acceso: (traducción alternativa) From the parking lot, head east and follow the Cypress West Trail. This trail runs more or less along the canyon all the way to a large bridge. Cross the bridge heading east, and after about 100 meters, turn left onto a narrow path until you see another path on the left. From there, the trail is marked with pink fabric strips all the way to the entry.		
Recorrido: (traducción alternativa) A fairly leisurely canyon with a few beautiful sections. There are five rappels, which pose no problems when the water level is moderate. There are also three jumps. In between, there are walking passages to reach the final rappel. This is the highest one at 28 meters, right in the middle of the water flow and with spectators watching.		
Regreso: (traducción alternativa) After the last 3-meter jump, continue along the canyon for about 200 meters until you see an exit on the right (rock steps that are easy to walk on). Climb up the rather steep slope to the trail. Follow the trail downhill back to the parking lot.
