Resumen: (traducción alternativa) A small forest canyon with low steps that can be downclimbed, slid down, or jumped over. The highlight is the 15-meter rappel at the Rickenbach Waterfall. An ideal stream for kids' hikes. There's also a small cave at the start with a slide leading out of it.		
Hidrología: (traducción alternativa) Water flow is generally low. The stream is passable even during rain or when the water level is higher.		
Acceso: (traducción alternativa) Coming from Bregenz, head toward the Langen Wirtatobel bus stop. Here, turn left onto Fluhstraße and then immediately right onto Wirtatobel Street. At the Wirtatobel parking lot, turn left onto Forstraße and follow Wirtatobel for another few hundred meters until the road slopes down to the stream on the right. Park your car there.		
Acceso: (traducción alternativa) The parking lot is located right at the entry. Once you've changed clothes, you're practically already in the stream, so there's no significant access required.		
Recorrido: (traducción alternativa) The tour is perfect for kids and features small slides, jumps, and a few rappelling sections. The slides and jumps can be repeated as often as you like. The tour begins with a short 2-meter rappel from a tree sling into a small cave. You can already slide here. From the cave, you can climb through another cave on the left and emerge back at the slide. Next, you'll reach a small jump. Here, you can also downclimb 2 meters via a fixed rope on either the left or right. After that, it's a 100-meter walk along the stream or on the adjacent hiking trail to the Rickenbach Falls. Here, you can rappel 15 meters down the waterfall on the right. A tree sling with a maillon is available. Otherwise, you can rappel from a tree on the right while staying dry. On the left side, there is a long fixed rope. Here, you can climb up a moderately steep section again and repeat the rappel point as often as you like. From a rock on the right, a 2-3-meter jump into the pool is possible. Continue downclimbing to the bridge over the stream. Here, after a few meters, you can slide down a 6-meter slide or exit orographically to the left before the bridge. If you're not done yet, you can rappel back into the stream from the bridge and repeat this rappel point as often as you like. Throughout the entire tour, it's possible to exit onto the hiking trails at any time, either to the left or right. This option can quickly become relevant, especially when hiking with children.		
Regreso: (traducción alternativa) From the bridge on Wirtatobel Street, follow the road back to the parking entry for a few hundred meters.
