<b>Resumen:</b> (traducción alternativa) A canyoning gem in the Kandertal valley near Reichenbach. A short but beautiful and rewarding descent.		
<b>Hidrología:</b> (traducción alternativa) Telephone number hydroelectric power station: +41 58 477 84 95 Do not underestimate the amount of water in this canyon and the warnings about the danger of sudden floods!  The water level must be assessed above the intake. At full capacity, 1,5000 l/s are turbined. In the event of an automatic shutdown, this amount of water can also be expected in the canyon...		
<b>Acceso:</b> (traducción alternativa) Approach via A8 exit 19 in Spiez and continue in the direction of Kandersteg. In Reichenbach turn left towards Kiental. The parking lot is located directly after the bridge over the Spiggenbach. The equipment can still be reached by car about 1.3 km in the direction of Griesalp to the Spiggengrund junction.		
<b>Acceso:</b> (traducción alternativa) Follow the road to Spiggengrund on foot for about 1.7 km until you reach the first bridge over the Spiggenbach stream just behind the dam.		
<b>Recorrido:</b> (traducción alternativa) Alongside the Gries and Gamchi canyons, the Spiggenbach is a canyoning gem in the Kandertal valley near Reichenbach (Bern/Berne/Berner Oberland). The canyon is very scenic and the abseils are a fun challenge. Caution: Don't tie out too early! In several places there were two steps down, this also applies to the C32!  Warning from the power plant operator: Staying on or in the streambed below the water intake of a hydroelectric power plant is dangerous. If there is a technical fault in the power station, the water level can suddenly rise. What is dangerous is that the so-called surge water can neither be prevented nor predicted in terms of time. Alongside the Gries and Gamchi canyons, the Spiggenbach is a canyoning gem in the Kandertal valley near Reichenbach (Bern/Berne/Berner Oberland). My 70m rope was twice as long everywhere. Approach via A8 exit 19 in Spiez and continue towards Kandersteg. In Reichenbach turn left towards Kiental. The parking lot is located directly after the bridge over the Spiggenbach. The equipment can still be driven about 1.3 km in the direction of Griesalp to the Spiggengrund junction. Follow the road to Spiggengrund on foot for about 1.7 km until you reach the first bridge over the Spiggenbach just after the weir. Never underestimate the amount of water in this canyon and the warnings regarding the danger of sudden floods!
