Resumen: (traducción alternativa) Dry canyon with rewarding 80m rappel (usually dry). Impressive views down to the sea and the coastline.		
Hidrología:		
Acceso: (traducción alternativa) From Dorgali we take the SS125 to Baunei. We pass through the town and 1.5 km after the end of the town we turn left off the SS125 onto a road that takes us down to Pietra Longa. After 3.6 km and about 260m before reaching the large parking lot at the end of the road, the trail "Selvaggio Blue" branches off from the road. On it we will come back at the exit of the tour. We will look for a suitable parking place, perhaps the large parking lot at the end of the road. to move the car for the exit see Google map in the "Photo Gallery".		
Acceso: (traducción alternativa) A rough track starts at the location of the second car and takes us eastwards to Bacu Olcoe'. From the exit of the track, it is only a few meters to the streambed.		
Recorrido: (traducción alternativa) Down the streambed we pass 3 wire fences and then come to the first rappel (24m). Further down, we pass a sparse deciduous wood and then reach the final verticals: 20m - 25m - 20m (diagonal abseil). The final 80m rappel can be split (15m+70m) to protect the rope. Beware of falling rocks in almost every rappel due to loose debris. Conclusion: a superiore amount of rappels for actually only the last beautiful 80m rappel. Sharp edges. Not in bad weather, wind, rain as there is a high risk of falling rocks.		
Regreso: (traducción alternativa) At the foot of the rock face, after the last big rappel half-right to the south, we come to the hiking trail that takes us to the car.
