Resumen: (traducción alternativa) Slate rock; some nice pools; some jumps; several downclimbs and walking passages; clean water; water level can change quickly; mostly aquatic even in summer; highest (57m) abseil point can be partially downclimbed. Exposure: West - best time to climb in the afternoon		
Hidrología:		
Acceso: (traducción alternativa) From Arbatax on the SS125 heading south (Cagliari); After several kilometers turn right towards "Bari Sardo" continue on the SS125; After a few more kilometers keep right at the fork towards Cardedu on the SS125; 3km after Cardedu there is a striking arched bridge where you turn right onto the SP28 towards Gairo S. Elena and drive up. Follow the road to Gairo, through Gairo to the stop sign. Continue downhill to the left on the SS198, over a bridge and briefly uphill towards Seui. Leave the main road at the hairpin bend with kilometre marker II 73 and turn right onto the concrete road. The concrete road soon becomes a gravel road, which you follow for 1.5 km. Here you park the transfer vehicle in the bulge before or after the forest road that leads down to the right. Take the 2nd car back to the village of Gairo. Pass the petrol station in the direction of Sarcerei. After leaving the village (Gairo), follow the mountain road for 2.8 km. On the left-hand side of the road, you will see a small gravel road branching off and leading down to the stream. There is parking right next to the stream.		
Acceso: (traducción alternativa) Enter the stream directly from the parking lot at 820m.		
Recorrido: (traducción alternativa) Riu Sarcerei is a varied, beautiful but discontinuous slate gorge with mostly short abseils. The short abseils are almost all in the water flow and should not be underestimated at higher water levels. The highest rappel of 55m goes over a sloping rock slab, which can be partially downclimbed, so 60m ropes are not absolutely necessary (assuming skillful downclimbing). Several steps can be bypassed or downclimbed and some pools invite you to jump. Towards the exit of the tour, the canyon becomes more incised. This is also where you have the most possible jumps. After the narrower part, the canyon opens up and you can walk the last 200m or so orthographic left along a path next to the stream. The Riu Sarcerei flows into the Riu Pardu here is also the exit at 550m.		
Regreso: (traducción alternativa) Follow the path over the Riu Sarcerei (the "Domu de Jamas" hiking sign on the right). Be careful not to follow the hiking signs to the right here, but go straight ahead to a stream of the Riu Pardu. Cross it and you will soon come to another signpost with the inscription "Forestedda - Su caminu de is paras. 0,35". Follow the clearly visible path to the right and then the forest road to the parking lot/shuttle car.
