Approach on left bank well steep and on trails not always obvious. At about elevation 950 keep left and enter on unclear tracks until you see the creek bed. The creek at first is a very sloping scree so descend carefully until water appears between your feet. Installed many weapons given the paucity of metal weapons present and now the descent is ok. Puddles never melted, many rappels with water overhead. Few walked sections between belays. Presence of at least two clear exit routes, both on the left bank. A third is in the second half and was serving the water catchment, now unusable and abandoned. At the exit of the gorge, after tunnel under railroad section, there is a fountain and two benches on which to conveniently remove your wetsuit. (traduction alternative)
