Résumé: (traduction alternative) A beautiful and watery hike comparable to the canyons in Friuli. Open and narrower sections alternate. By bike (about 40 minutes), you can significantly shorten the access and park right at the exit. This reduces the access time from 2.5 hours to 1.5 hours, with 40 minutes of walking passages.

Approche: (traduction alternative) Ride your bike from the car park to the fountain. From there, it's about 40 minutes to the entry.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) There are many small steps and rappels of up to 30 meters, alternating with one another. There are quite a few wooden sections along the route. The water is relatively cold at the beginning.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) After the last rappel, the canyon opens up again. Climb out to the side and follow the hiking trail back to the bike parking area.

Great canyon. You could also start the hike halfway down by rappelling down into the canyon from the trail as it climbs uphill. It's just as rewarding, since there's still a 30-meter rappel down the waterfall. Shortly before the end, there's a relatively tight snag. Make sure to leave the ropes long and continue to rappel straight down. We didn't find any anchors at that spot (the snag). (traduction alternative)

A very rewarding route. Cycling there significantly shortens the access, and the return trip is a pleasure. The route could definitely use 3–4 more anchors; we rappelled down 2 to 3 steps in some sections. There's still quite a bit of wood along the route that needs to be downclimbed, but that isn't too bothersome given the many beautiful sections. Some rappel points are right in the stream's current, which could become problematic when the water level is high. Mix of 8mm and 10mm bolts (traduction alternative)
