Résumé: (traduction alternative) Attractive, but unfortunately short canyon with beautiful views. Located in the Karwendel nature reserve ("Naturpark"). Can be easily combined with the Birkkarbach in one day.		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) From one of the parking lots at the beginning of the Hintertal valley on the eastern edge of Scharnitz, cycle for about 1 hour to the end of the valley at the Kastental (1220m old). Alternatively, you can take the Karwendel cab (Taxi Mair) to the Kastental if you don't have a bike or don't want to pedal.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) After crossing the stream, follow the path until it leads back into the streambed (entry)		
Tour: (traduction alternative) Mostly only small-sized waste, see photos and video		
Retour: (traduction alternative) Where the path crosses the streambed, turn left out to the bikes. On the bike down to Scharnitz.
