Résumé: (traduction alternative) Very short but beautiful tour; well combinable with Schwarzenbach near Forchach; emergency exits before and after the highest rappel stage; rock hole at C16; exposure east; very well equipped; commercially climbed; sedimentary rock.		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) From Reutte to the village of Stanzach. Immediately after the village, turn right towards Vorderhornbach. Follow the country road over the Lech. Immediately after the bridge (approx. 50m) there is a large parking lot on the left. Park here.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) From the parking lot, briefly follow the road back to the bridge and then continue along the cycle path downstream until you reach a yellow signpost "Moos, Baichlstein". From here, follow the wide forest road slightly uphill to a beautiful viewpoint with a wooden bench. Directly after the bend with the wooden bench, a small path leads down to the streambed on the right. Entry at approx. 1020m.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) The tour is very short and is commercially accessible, but is still worthwhile. After a short section of walking terrain, the canyon narrows and the first well-secured abseiling points in the water appear. Thanks to fixed ropes and good belays, most of the steps can be negotiated safely even at higher water levels. If the pools are not currently covered in gravel, a few small steps can also be slid. The highlight in the middle of the gorge is a 90° left-hand bend with a rock hole. This is also the highest rappel point (16m) in the water jet (can also be rappelled dry through the rock hole if the water level is high. After the highest abseil point, there are three smaller steps of max. 7m before the canyon exits much too quickly.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) Either get off before or after the cycle path bridge and follow the cycle path to the right back to the parking lot.

We tacked this on as a second tour after our big Strindenbach loop, as a finale. You can clearly tell that the canyon is commercially developed by the large amount of metal in it. Rope traverses made of stainless steel cables, chain anchors with adhesive anchors—sometimes three per rappeler, on the left and right, either inside or outside the gorge. Fixed ropes for downclimbing or rappelling. In the end, we set up two rappelling points. The rest could be downclimbed or rappelled using the rope traverse or fixed ropes. The canyon is really fun and is over way too quickly. So it's a pretty good way to wrap up the day, but not worth it as a half-day or full-day tour. There are just too many other beautiful canyons in the Lech Valley for that. But as a short after-work tour or to fill a couple of hours, it's more than worth it and really beautiful! Generally quite grippy, but slippery in places. (traduction alternative)
