Résumé: (traduction alternative) Long and watery rappel canyon		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) From Domodossola, head west into the Bogna Valley in the direction of Fonti. After approx. 7 km you pass a long bridge from which you can see the last cascades of the Variola. 850 m further on, the road to Pioi goes off to the left. Park your car here. If you want to get out before the passage with the 68 m rappel and longer walking distance (recommended, as the last part is not very rewarding and then 2x30 m of rope are enough for a highest rappel of not quite 25 m), park the lower car 570 m further on the access road at the entrance to Fonti, just before the bridge over the Bogna. Immediately after the bridge, the hiking trail from Monsignore, on which we will return, is on the right. In the second car, continue through the village of Fonti and then take the winding road uphill via San Lorenzo, Graniga and Pianzola. After a total of 8.7 km (counted from the lower car at the road junction to Pioi), we come to a 90° left-hand bend to some houses scattered on the slope (1290 m above sea level). Here you can see a post with signposts. We park the second car nearby. If you only want to walk the part after the water drainage, turn off in the direction of Mulera and park behind the small church.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) First, walk up the hill for a while and pass between a few houses (fountain on the left). We follow the signpost "Ponte Alpe Baim" on a path in a horizontal northerly direction. After a while we come to a tree trunk with large lettering. Here the main path goes down to the right to the bridge (1100) - lower access (time saving compared to the upper access is a good 1 hour). The path to the upper entry goes left here and is marked with red markings. Follow them past a ruined house to the stream. Middle entry: From the church, follow the forest path downhill until you reach the power station. Pass between the two buildings and descend behind the building on the right onto the tube. Follow the tube until you can descend to the right to the streambed after the first tunnel. (Duration 20min)		
Tour: (traduction alternative) Long and great descent with slides, possible jumps, bottlenecks and pools flooded with sun (if the sun shines). At the water drainage you can get out if necessary, if the water flow seems too strong for the following bottlenecks. If we also want to hook the lower part, we have to carry a 60m rope in addition to 2x30m rope.		

Retour: (traduction alternative)

Turn left before the old stone bridge and cross the bridge to the right on the hiking trail to Fonti. If the last part with the 68m ropes (can be broken 50/20) is also walked, at the barrage on the orographic left side of the Rio Bogna a few hundred meters uphill until you see a path on the opposite side that leads up to the lower car. In August 2025 the direct way back was closed by the authorities (landslide), instead get out via Valpiana, about 120hm and 15min more.

Automatisch importiert von Descente-Canyon.com für Canyon Rasiga Only did superior part, from 1230m to the dam at 860m. DC+. All anchors OK, although once or twice we didn't find an anchor where we would've liked one. Trees came in handy though. With this water level nothing is dangerous, but a bit more and some non-equipped downclimbs could be troublesome. Rope-wise the upper part of Rasiga is like a v3, but this doesn't make it a beginner canyon! The water is cold and you spend a lot of time in it, there's a lot of walking and climbing blocks in the river, there's no cell service anywhere, it's slippery, there's no obvious échaps, ... Whether you think this canyon deserves it's rating here will depend on how much you enjoy walking/scrambling in a river. It's beautiful, but it's a lot - we took 6h with two. Exit via the big tube was fine, my comment from a couple of days ago was perhaps a bit too careful, it all went very smoothly even after an exhausting canyon.
