<b>Résumé:</b> (traduction alternative) Rappel canyon in conglomérate		
<b>Hydrologie:</b>		
<b>Accès:</b> (traduction alternative) From Bierge, on the southern edge of Sierra Guara, towards Rodellar. At km 8, park car under a large tree (the same place as the access to the Bco. Cueva Cabrito).		
<b>Approche:</b> (traduction alternative) Either the ascent path of the Bco Cueva Cabrito down and in the Estrechos de Balcés a piece upwards or the ascent path of the Xuncar down and in the Estrechos a piece downwards - until then about 1 hour each (see sketch at <a href="http://mb16.club.fr/CANYON/SecteurIsuala/Cautiecho/CadreCaut.htm">http://mb16.club.fr/CANYON/SecteurIsuala/Cautiecho/CadreCaut.htm</a> ). Recommended as an access route is the Bco. Xuncar (Juncar) - 2 hrs., max. rappel 18 m - which enters the Balcés opposite the mouth of the Cautiecho, there about 30 m downstream and then more or less pathless up to the 'Brujas' - another 3/4 hrs. The ascent route from the Balcés is the same for all variants. Entry at the 'Brujas' is expedient, since the Cautiecho further above does not offer too much. Also an access from the exit of the Balcés Oscuros on a hiking trail is possible. Return then in the Balcés Estrechos upstream (For this variant see gallery).		
<b>Tour:</b> (traduction alternative) If you have the rare good fortune to be able to walk the Cautiecho with running water, you should pay special attention to guaranteeing the rope retrieval during the magnificent 40 m rappel, as the chain anchor is designed for dry conditions.		
<b>Retour:</b> (traduction alternative) Either the Xuncar ascent trail or the Cueva Cabrito ascent to the car (about 1.25 hrs.).
