German Alpine Road - B 305, 6 km from Inzell southwards, or 5 km from Schneizlreuth northwards to the southern end of Weißbach on the Alpine Road. Here turn onto Sägmühlweg and cross the Weißbach, then continue for a few meters "am Litzlbach" in a southwesterly direction. drive past the Wertstoffhof and park your car at the next road branching off to the left.

Approche: (traduction alternative)

At the parking lot, cross the Litzlbach stream and follow the path for about 850m until you reach a steep bend to the right. We do not follow the forest road further around the bend but continue straight into the forest. Follow the path for about 500m until you reach a crossroads. There straight on. Go another 550m to a trail branching off to the left and then follow it until the creek approaches at about 3 hm and enter the Scharnbach. Very overgrown because little used. (00h 50')

Tour: (traduction alternative)

Rappel and downclimb over smaller steps, small slides, smooth "terrain", always deadwood obstacles to overcome. Then the C27, again downclimbing over deadwood, a narrower passage, some possible jumps and finally in the open creek bed out to the bridge and the exit.

Retour: (traduction alternative)

After the confluence with a stream coming from the right (southwestern direction), we continue walking for about 200 m in the now open streambed, before we get off to the right up to the bridge. Over the bridge to the left on the slope in the direction NNW downhill, finally again over the Litzlbach, to the village and the car. (00h 15`)

The amount of fallen trees in the Scharnbach has unfortunately increased from "a lot" to "way too many". Also one of the slipperiest canyons out there. Together this makes for a slow, strenuous and not very fun experience. Maybe a future flood can clear some of these trees out, but until then, I don't think I will be doing the Scharnbach anymore. Important Info: The bridge at the end of the canyon (which you use for the normal exit) is completely off-limits. The wooden boards have rotten through, and major holes in the bridge make it extremely dangerous!
