<b>Résumé:</b> (traduction alternative) Scenic, narrow gorge with quite alpine access.		
<b>Hydrologie:</b>		
<b>Accès:</b> (traduction alternative) Take the B115 between Hieflau and Eisenerz in the direction of Radmer a.d. Hasel. Follow this road for about 5km until a deep valley opens up on the left. Before the bridge, there is parking space for about 3 cars on the right. It is important not to park after the bridge, parking is absolutely forbidden.		
<b>Approche:</b> (traduction alternative) From the parking lot briefly on a forest road to transmission tower, then over well-trodden hunters path up the left flank. After an unpleasant traverse of a landslide quite exposed traverse 100m above the valley floor. After about 50 minutes the path meets the stream again. Here is the entry.		
<b>Tour:</b> (traduction alternative) After 10 minutes of block hopping, you are at the beginning of the gorge and at the first rappelling point. From here no emergency exit is possible. In the gorge, rappelling points up to 13m alternate with walking / downclimb passages. Scenic, the whole thing is very impressive, partly the gorge is so narrow that no sunbeam comes to the bottom, with suitable water level (estimate at the first rappel point) but not too demanding. Go only in good weather. Due to the rocky catchment area, changes due to debris are possible.		
<b>Retour:</b> (traduction alternative) After the exit of the gorge always in the streambed to the parking lot.

We did not complete the canyon. During the approach, we encountered a large landslide that had completely destroyed the trail. We managed to bypass it carefully along the upper edge below the rock face and eventually rejoined the path. Several sections of the trail were also blocked by fallen trees. We strongly recommend wearing a helmet during the approach, as we observed rocks falling from above on several occasions. During the afternoon ascent, we noticed dark storm clouds building up in the valley and could see lightning in the distance. Considering the weather conditions and the increasing storm activity, we decided to turn back before entering the canyon.

A short but very pretty, narrow canyon with a decent amount of water. Of the seven rappelling points, five were in good condition, but the third and fourth are already a bit worn. The approach to the canyon is dangerous—definitely more so than the canyon itself. (traduction alternative)

Slightly woody at the beginning but very easy to walk on. Stands all in good condition (traduction alternative)

Inspection canyoning rescue mountain rescue Styria 28.06.2025 All anchors in order, one anchor was additionally drilled, one loose nut tightened. Some wood in the canyon but not disturbing. General condition fully OK. Access: after the barrier follow the forest road to the left to Jadgsitz, directly behind it the path goes away. At the gravel cracks partly no longer clearly visible. Current topographic view follows. (traduction alternative)

Access not clear, especially at the beginning, the first 150 meters a bit tedious over gravel, then clearer climbing traces, in any case up to the foot of the wall. Insurance in the canyon ok but not top, should be renewed, one sling renewed, (traduction alternative)

Stands partly a bit rusty but everything ok. Some new trees in the access and canyon, but all doable without problems. Have fun! (traduction alternative)

Narrow cold canyon with challenging approach - approach route partly crossed by trees. A lot of cragging at the start (more than in 2022), some of the stances rusty and bolts loose. But in July 2023 still ok for abseiling. Watch out for loose stones when abseiling. (traduction alternative)

Currently good water. Unfortunately, a few more trees in the gorge than last season. Not yet disturbing. Hooks are still ok or could be better. Watch out on the approach. (traduction alternative)
