<b>Approche:</b> (traduction alternative) Either walk or drive from the exit of the road to Verdabbio. From Verdabbio another 30 min access on foot.		
<b>Tour:</b> (traduction alternative) First rappel with four rappels a nice start. In the second rappel there is an intermediate belay. Then we walk and downclimb some scree until rappels follow again. Now more and more rappels follow until at the exit we scramble down the steep streambed through scree for 10-15 minutes. Beware of many loose and large stones on the entire tour.
