We will take the C-17 to Ripoll, there we will take the C-26 and then the N-260 towards Sant Joan de les Abadesses, where a little more than a kilometer past the town we will take the C-38 to Camprodon. Once in Camprodon, turn left at the traffic circle to Setcases and Vilallonga de Ter, on the GIV5264. After Vilallonga, at the p.k. 7.7, we will find the detour to the left to Tregurà, crossing over the river Ter. We enter this lush and almost always wet valley, to climb along its zigzagging road to Tregurà Baix. We will pass a first row of houses before reaching a very tight right fork, where we will have a track that goes straight ahead. We park the return car in this fork, there is room to do so without disturbing. With the access car we will continue going up to Tregurà Dalt, we will arrive to the upper small square and we will continue on the right to follow the camí de Tregurà a Ribesaltes towards the Creu de Fusta (in google maps it appears as camí de Fontlletera). The track continues west and north direction until it makes a turn to the south to close the cirque, we will pass by the Refugi Claus and soon the track will change direction to the east, we head to the pass of Meianell. About 200m after the pass, the track turns right in a tight hairpin. Place to park.

Approche: (traduction alternative)

By the path that goes east to the Collada de Meianell, when we reach it we will see to our left and the basin of the Torrentera and glimpse a path that brings us closer to the riverbed by its orographic right. We will be at about 1900m, we must follow this path to the right until the confluence with its tributary der at about 1770m, at which point we will enter the channel.

After the dam we can go left to a path that leads to the Tregurà dam and from there follow the path to the parking lot back.
If we get to the Tregurà riverbed, we must cross it and leave on its orographic left, on the other side we will see some red marks that lead us to a path that soon joins the previous one, about 200m before reaching the road.

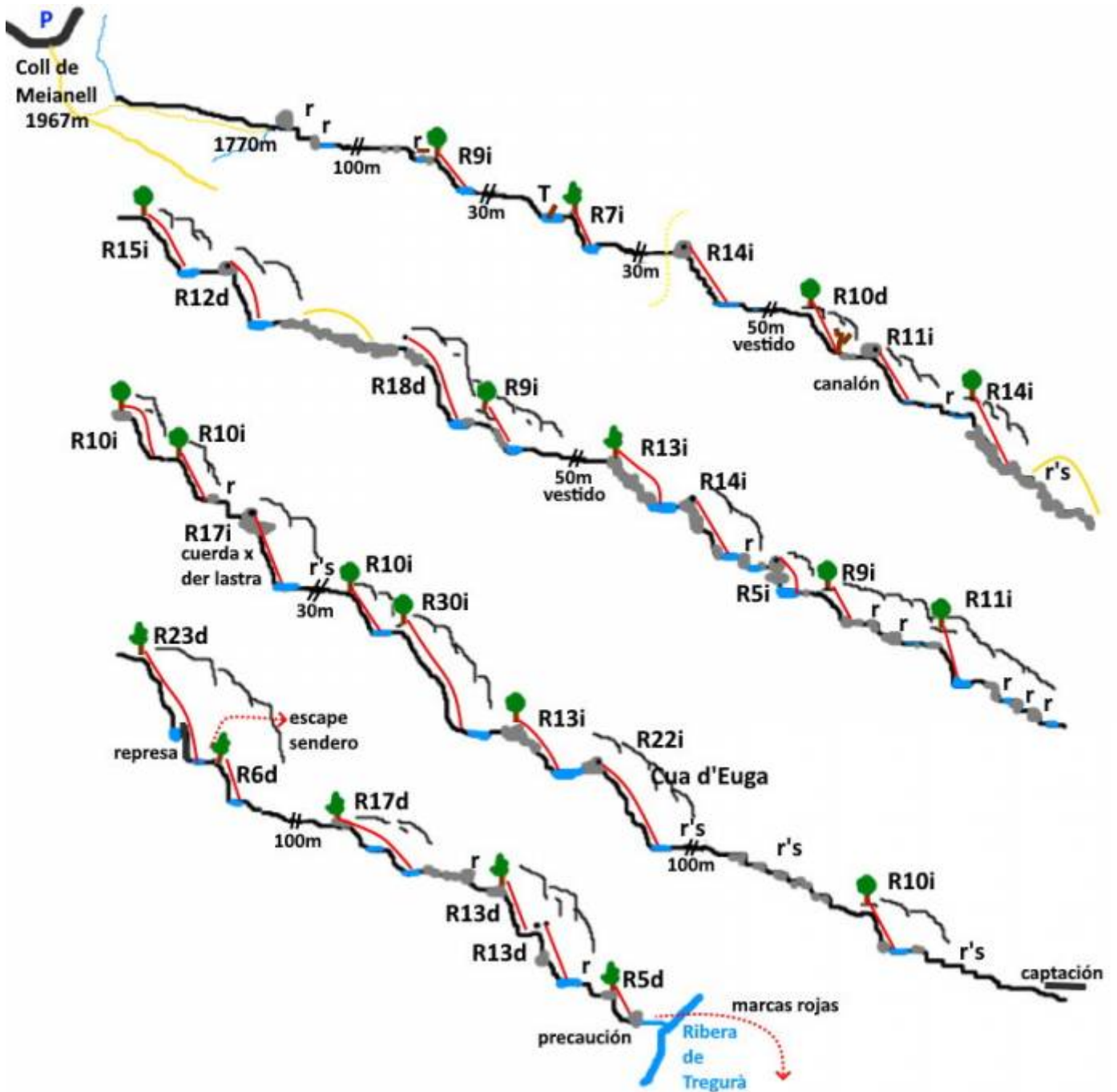
