Résumé: (traduction alternative) The upper part is an impressively narrow canyon in white, solidly banked limestone with some nice slides and jumps. The lower part is more open and less attractive. Relatively good hooking, even at high water. Only 1 stand always has something going on.		
Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) Takes water from subterranean reservoirs. Ideal in spring or after rain.		
Accès: (traduction alternative) A28 until the Fontanafredda exit, from here follow the signs for Aviano. After passing the US military base, go straight towards Budoia. Cross the village of Dardago and follow the road into the valley of Torrente Cunaz. Park at the second inn.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) Follow the asphalt road for a short while, then turn right onto the marked trail 990a, soon after turn right again onto trail 994. This trail shortens several hairpin bends of the old road. When you see the narrow gorge of Torrente Cunaz below you, climb briefly before descending on a clear path to the streambed that you reach just above the gorge.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) After a series of slides, you reach the first abseiling point. <ul style="list-style-type: none">* 6m from anchor left* 14m from anchor left* 7m from anchor left* 6m slide - can also be repeated via an adventurous rope ladder/rope railing construction* 18m rappel over a hanging pool from anchor left (you can also jump or slide into the first pool)* 18m from anchor on the right* 10m from anchor on the right* 4m jump/slide* 7m rappel from anchor with chain left* 25m rappel from 2 anchors on the right - beautiful rock cauldron From here the canyon is more open - downclimbs and short slides/jumps alternate, one 12m rappel. The tour exits above a weir		
Retour: (traduction alternative) Left on driveway, a gate on the right immediately back to the parking lot

Beautiful white limestone, nice atmosphere, though only 4 stars for the upper part with good water. Overall suprisingly well bolted, for high flow also ok, only one location obviously is a conflictive area with many damaged/missing anchors - newly drilled one M10 on the left bank, somewhat higher than the original lines (one damaged anchor right bank, or chock stones could also be usable in case of emergency).
