Résumé: (traduction alternative) Canyon in a secluded location with some beautiful passages but also a lot of climbing in the dry bed		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) Take the A23 to the Carnia exit, then follow the main road briefly in the direction of Tolmezzo. After Cavazzo Carnia, turn off and follow the signs for Gemona, turn right in Somplago and drive along Lago di Cavazzo to the campsite. After the campsite, drive under the highway bridge and then immediately turn right onto a sand road - follow this sand road to the parking entry.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) Only briefly follow the sand road into the valley of the Rio Nembrinette, when the road leaves the streambed, turn right onto a small path (small cairn, path is narrow but clear). Follow this path steeply to an abandoned mountain pasture, then cross less steeply into the valley of the Rio Garmoran (many red markings at the end). When you reach the rocky dry bed of the Rio Teis, descend. Entry above a beautiful plunge pool.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) 3m jump into a nice round pool, then a short slide into another deep but small pool. The water then seeps away and a long hiking/climbing section begins with a short 10m tree abseil. When the water reappears, a few short slides and downclimbs follow, and a few jumps are also possible. A 20m drop is rappelled from 2 anchors on the left, then a short downclimb/hike until you reach the last high drop into the Rio da Cout valley: a short downclimb, then an 18m rappel from the left (the narrow pool is jumpable, but the drop afterwards is not), then a 50m rappel from two anchors on the right over a beautiful waterfall. From here it's just hiking/downclimbing with two possible jumps.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) Through the streambed back to the starting point

Dry canyon; even after yesterday's heavy rain, there's almost no water. Anchors—well, you mostly have to rely on trees; you can't slide or jump in any other spot; the rest is completely covered in debris. !!WARNING!! At the start of the last third of the tour, there's a rockfall blocking 80% of the canyon. There's quite a bit of climbing on slippery terrain, so a good sense of balance is required. (traduction alternative)
