Résumé: (traduction alternative) North-facing limestone tour, some very beautiful rocks. Best done in May when it is still nice and sunny but the snow at the top is not yet melting at full speed.		
Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) Small catchment area, but glacier on top. So the amount of water changes greatly on warm days.		
Accès: (traduction alternative) Park at the col du Pillon.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) The hiking trail goes up directly at the col, then take the turn-off to the right after the hollow.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) Smaller gulches with 2-3 waterfalls followed by the C90, then another slab before the rock gets very light and makes nice pools.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) Turn right onto the hiking trail.
