Located on the south face of the Sierra de Orihuela, it consists of 8 rappels. It starts at the famous Paso del Gato, which we will access from the parking lot located between the Red Cross and the N-340 following the path that leads to the climbing areas of Momiog.

Getting to Orihuela

On the N340, just before the tunnel, we have on the right the Oriolet street, next to the Red Cross. Place to park.

We cross the N-340 and take the path that leads us to the Momiog climbing areas, at this point we will begin the ascent to the aforementioned pass, in this section we will pay special attention because at some points it is necessary to use the hands (steps II^o and III^o) once over the first ledge in which we clearly pass from the south face to the west we have on the left the access to the third rappel, a vira with milestones, if we want to do it whole we have to continue climbing to the R1, take it with tranquility because it is steep, at the end of the last ledge before the cable that protects the Paso del Gato we will take to the left by a terrace, at the end of this we will find the R1, composed of handrails (parabolts+maillon) and two Long Life, once finished the first rappel we will go to look for the bed of the ravine, 100 m walking, immediately we will find the R2 D, destrepable, we only have to follow the indications of the review.

Once the ravine is finished, we will leave to the left bordering the wall up to a shelter used to light a fire, at this point we will follow the path in an ascending direction in southeast direction leaving the wall to our left, we will pass by a shelter used as an outhouse since a little further on we will find the sport climbing area El Paraje, we will continue surrounding the wall, this always to our left until we find the path by which we climbed previously.

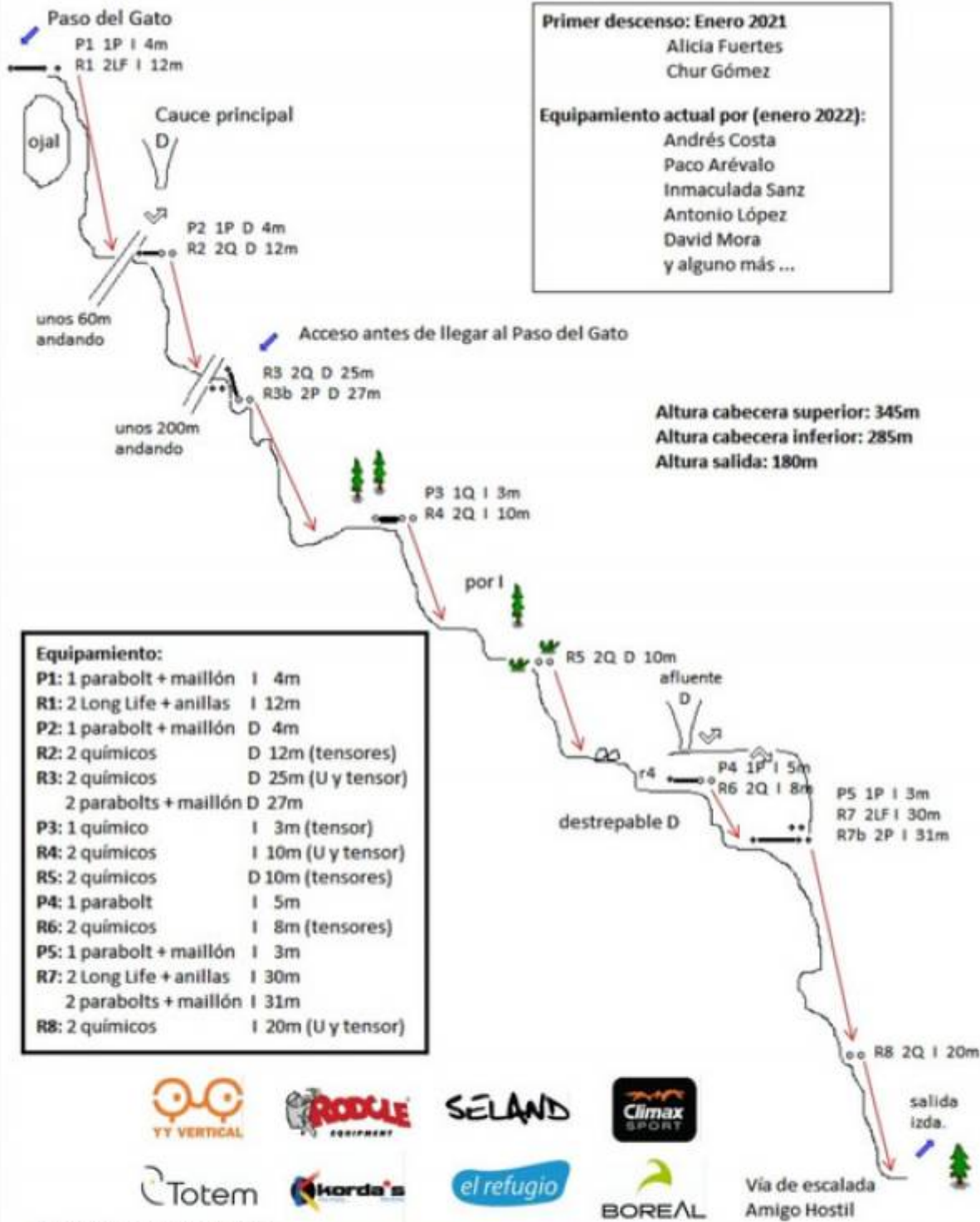
