Spécialités: Glacier dans le bassin versant,		
Matériel: Cordes: 2x40m		
Résumé: (traduction alternative) Glacier gorge with three parts. 1. narrow and deeply incised 2. more open 3. threatening.		
Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) You can escape between the individual parts via the long-distance hiking trail. A glacier feeds the canyon. The water level drops as soon as it freezes at 2000 m every day. The canyon is very narrow and has active abseiling points. In the middle of the second narrow section, the canyon receives a spring. The ideal starting flow rate is around 70 l/s for the exit of 100 to 120 l/s.		
Accès: (traduction alternative) From Bern, drive in the direction of Interlaken. Turn off towards Kandersteg. Drive to the village and then continue up the valley towards Selden. You have to pay 10 francs at an automatic toll booth to drive on the road through the canyon. Please note, certain ascent times apply to the one-way road (between 45 and 10 for the ascent). The route leads through tunnels and crosses the Kander. As soon as you come to a passable bridge leading back to RG, take it and park a little further on next to the Forsthaus Waldhus. It is possible to take the cable car up before the toll station. From the top station you have to walk back down to the river.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) Take the path that leads past the forester's lodge and follow the signs to the Sunnbüel cable car, Gemmi Pass. The GR leaves the path to the right and approaches the last waterfall of the third part. The path runs along the side of the mountain and is dizzying in places. You reach a bridge that overlooks the second part. Now you climb up to the right and reach a path. Follow this for 200 m and a small path leads you naturally into the open part of the canyon.		

Tour: (traduction alternative)

3 separate parts, separated by hiking trails.

The canyon narrows immediately. The waterfalls plunge under boulders. The passages are very aesthetic.

The hike is quite short, less than 10 minutes, and you reach the bridge of the second part. Here, too, the canyon immediately becomes narrower and steeper. The waterfalls get bigger and some of the stands require an MC. The most beautiful is the 35 m high waterfall under an aesthetic rock arch. You can pass RD both below in the water and outside the water.

The next parts are longer and the terrain is a bit unstable. The GR approaches and immediately afterwards the river descends with the same force as in the other parts. The rappels are always aesthetic. After a less aesthetic and more open part, you reach the last waterfalls. The penultimate abseil of 22 m exits in a deep pool, with a dangerous current RD at high water level. You pass a new waterfall and outside the narrow section you find the last points in the fossil riverbed RG.

Retour: (traduction alternative)

You leave RD and reach a path and the GR.
