At 37°51.14594'N, 15°15.67966'E take the small asphalt road on the right. You can park your car at 37°51.46847'N, 15°16.01785'E. There is hardly any parking further on.		
<b>Approche:</b> (traduction alternative) As shown on the Google.sketch (red color - see under photo gallery)  At the exit of the driveway above the building, cross the stream and follow the path through terraced terrain to a ridge. Here descend diagonally down the barely visible path to the beginning of the canyon.		

**Tour:** (traduction alternative)

8 rappels, the highest right at the beginning.

Large valley to the west below Castelmola. There are probably 3 sections of the gorge that can be climbed. Information could only be found about 2 parts.

The following canyon is dry even after rain. Some small pools can be crossed.

**Retour:** (traduction alternative)

Either on the slope up to "P 1" and then on to "P 2" or, as described by the French, after an influx from the right over the slopes, up to the ridge without a path and on this up to "P2".

Another option would be for someone to choose the exit of the French and then take the car from "P 2" to "P 1", where the others wait after walking up the slope to "P 1". (brown colors - see photo gallery)

Alternative description: A few meters before the stream (small waterfall) you can take a very steep path up the slope on the right. If you follow the stream up to a path, the last few meters are very overgrown and difficult to overcome. The path to the right is very pleasant. When you reach the access road, turn right back to the P.

Further gorge sections in the large valley to the west below Castelmola. You can at least find water here after rain. From Villagonia, take the narrow road under the highway up the valley. It is best to park respectfully on the road at 37°51.00493'N, 15°16.24045'E next to the house. At 37°51.00493'N, 15°16.24045'E turn right down a bad road to the entry 37°51.27721'N, 15°16.26473'E. To be on the safe side, you can install a fixed rope (20m) as an emergency exit at the pipe bridge visible from above. The gorges are very overgrown. Depending on the vegetation, head into the streambed and through the reeds to the first abseil point. v3a2IV Good equipment 1. 4m 2. 3 m hanging rope 3. 4m 4. several short T partly with BH 5. 2BH 3 m access to 14 m rappel, chain 6. short T The 14 m rappel in the watercourse is, depending on the water supply, the most rewarding part of the canyon. After the old water building, immediately take the barely visible path on the right (garden shears helpful) up to the pipe bridge and from there continue up to the access. (traduction alternative)
