Approche: (traduction alternative) From the exit point of the tour, climb up to the power station on the mountain. A metal bridge follows after the power station. From here, follow the power lines and keep to the left. After about 20 minutes, you come to an open area with some ruins. Immediately after this would be a dry footbed (access or exit possible). Now it is only about 30 minutes to the entry via the hiking trail.

It was completely dry in lower section above metal bridge where is last 2 verticals, we made mistake trying to enter this canyon in summer, so we switched to Prishtes which is close and with some water

The rock was slippery. The anchors were well placed and in good condition. Unfortunately, we had to enter through the dry footbed in the open area as we couldn't find the access and had time problems. The rappels were nice in the sun and if we had dived out we could have even done a few jumps. The water level flowed well and did not stagnate. The water was a beautiful turquoise color, but the temperature almost reminded us of a glacier gorge. (traduction alternative)
