Résumé: (traduction alternative) Like many other canyons in Mallorca, water only flows through after rainfall. Beautiful, sometimes high rappels, mostly sintered.		
Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) Be careful, the water can path extremely quickly when it rains. And not only during extreme thunderstorms! When water is walking, a heavy shower can be enough.		
Accès: (traduction alternative) Leave the ring road around Palma via exit 58 onto the Ma1110 and head north. After 6.8 km, at the traffic circle near the scattered houses of S'Esgleieta (a restaurant on the righthand side), continue north on the Ma 1110. After another 7.9 km we reach the center of Valldemossa. Continue - now on the Ma1130 - in the direction of Andratx. After about 900m we leave the road junction to Soller on the right and after about 400m we come to the junction (right, NNW) in the direction of Port/Marina de Valldemossa. Here we turn onto the Ma1131. A good 600 meters later, immediately after a slight right-hand bend, there is a narrow grass verge on the left-hand side of the road where you can park without disturbing the traffic. We are now a few meters from the road bridge over the stream. Parking further down means obstructing traffic and this is inevitably associated with the sport of canyoning, which cannot be in anyone's interest. A second car can be parked down in Port de Valldemossa beforehand. It is not socially acceptable to park on the way there. And even in the town itself, it is rather unpleasant to stand out. There is only a decent parking lot at the bottom of the harbour. But then the walk up is almost shorter. So it's easy to get there by car.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) There are various descriptions to get into the water. Orograf. to the left of the bridge a few meters downstream we come to the streambed. The book "L'illa dels torrents" by Barceló/Trias describes an access from the orographic right side of the stream directly from the car parked in front of the hamlet. The alternative access via Torrent Rafal also inevitably leads over private land.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) We climb or ropes down the streambed. After about 200m, the water of Torrent Rafal splashes down from the top left. A jump is possible here if the pool is full. This is also the case several times in the following sections. In addition to several rappels over 20 to 35 meters, we also come across the "Gran Salta" with 55m. In total, we manage around 15 rappels. After the last rappel, we walk and climb further down the streambed.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) Before a large rock in the streambed, turn right out to the road and follow it downhill to the car, but only if there is a second car at the bottom. Otherwise, it is best to walk up the road.

Despite the supposedly best time of year, completely dry except for a few stale pools. The "inflow" from the left was a sweet trickle, so still dry as dust, the pools also completely empty, so be careful not to rappel too far into the empty pools. Only one would cause problems for getting out, but there is a fixed rope mounted there as an ascent aid. However, many of the abseiling sections can be climbed down, and the rock is generally quite grippy. We sweated ourselves to death in our wetsuits, but would have been fine in a T-shirt and trousers :) Sinter formations are beautiful but not very rewarding without water. Cell phone reception is also possible in the meantime, as the canyon is very open (traduction alternative)
