Résumé: (traduction alternative) Short, watery rappel canyon		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) From Pfronten between Kempten and Füssen on the B309 in the direction of Vils/Reutte. Cross the German/Austrian border and park 250m further on the large square on the left in front of the houses of the hamlet Schönbichl.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) About 500m on the B309 back to the old customs house. Immediately after the houses turn left onto the forest road that runs SW towards the foot of the slope. The path approaches the Reichenbach on its orographic left side in a weak right curve. After 950 m the forest road bends to the right (on the righthand side a barn under a tree). A few meters further on, the path to the Reichenbachklamm turns off to the left. It now goes up as a steeply ascending path in the direction of Aggenstein at the edge of the Reichenbach gorge. Here you can also see the lower waterfalls. Leave the path where it leaves the stream and walk along the canyon rim in 10 minutes to the entry.		
Tour: (traduction alternative) After a short run you come to the first rappel (5 m). A little later to the high rappel, which you pass outside the beam. The following small steps can be unpleasant in case of strong water flow. After a short run further rappel outside the rappel. Before a narrow chute we went out to the left and bypassed it on a wire rope insurance. Then the short canyon exits. The Reichenbach is a German/Austrian border stream - so stick to the Austrian side because canyoning is generally prohibited by law in German streams (the only known exception is the Kesselbach near Bad Reichenhall).		
Retour: (traduction alternative) After the ferrata at the big rock in the streambed left up to the footpath and on the access path back to the car.
