Résumé: (traduction alternative) Tributary to the Ribeira Funda		
Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) Initially rather little water. Runs into the Ribeira Funda, so be sure to check the water levels of the Ribeira Funda!		
Accès: (traduction alternative) VE2 highway from Seixal to Porto Moniz. If you only have one car, you can park in Ribeira Funda (see parking lot for access). Large groups with several vehicles should park at the exit of Seixal (see "Access and exit" parking lot), which extends the access by 750 meters. It is not recommended to park a car in front of the steep tunnel near the exit (exit parking lot), as there is often rockfall from the steep slopes above. DO NOT park in the newer rescue tunnel, you will be ticketed and/or your vehicle will be towed away.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) From the parking lot in Ribeira Funda, walk slightly uphill through the houses to the south. After a good 10 minutes you are at the entry to Ribeira Funda. Cross the (mostly dry) stream and continue on the poorly visible path until you reach the neighboring gorge (approx. 25 min). The path walks parallel to the Funda through the wooded slope. (30 minutes) From the official parking lot, take the old coastal road heading northwest and follow it until you reach an old, steep tunnel. Follow the road uphill to its exit, see above. (Approx. 40 minutes in total)		
Tour: (traduction alternative) At the beginning, you struggle a little against sometimes prickly undergrowth. In the upper part, there are abseils at heights of 45, 35 and 20 meters. The equipment is OK, but nothing more. Leads into the Ribeira Funda, so that you can continue with the beautiful final passage of the Funda.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) As with Ribeira Funda, the tour exits directly on the old coastal road along the Atlantic. Follow this road to the right for a few minutes to the parking exit. (approx. 5 minutes) If you only have one car in Ribeira Funda, the way back is self-explanatory. After climbing over the wall, simply follow the old road through the tunnels to Ribeira Funda (approx. 15 minutes). If you have parked in the official parking lot, follow the old road for another 700 meters until you reach the new road. Turn left here to the parking lot. (approx. 10 minutes)
