Matériel: Cordes: 2x30m outil de forage,		
Résumé: (traduction alternative) Short, steep access (Dopplersteig) and short canyon; cold water; many cloisters; several short rappel (mostly in the water); caution in rain / thunderstorm! ; Rockfall hazard (by hikers); lower part almost continuously cut; in the upper part are r. several steep emergency exits possible.		
Hydrologie:		
Accès: (traduction alternative) From Sbg. south towards Fürstenbrunn --> after the shooting range in the Glanegg district there is a sharp bend to the left --> then continue straight ahead for approx. 100m and park on the left in the forest (parking lot for the forest cemetery or hiking trail via Dopplersteig, under 1h parking meter afterwards €4,-).		
Approche: (traduction alternative) From the parking lot follow the gravel path past the houses to the Rositten bridge (= exit at 460m) --> here follow the steep hiking trail 460 towards Zepezauerhaus --> before the 3rd concrete obstruction visible on the hiking trail (approx. 30min walking time) follow the small steep path right down to the stream at approx. 670m. (Most canyoneers, however, usually enter the stream after approx. 15 minutes of access in order to make only the more beautiful lower part of the canyon).		
Tour: (traduction alternative) The canyon is rather open and unspectacular in the upper part -->several small drop-offs follow one another. Several small rappels, walking and climbing passages follow each other until the canyon narrows -> from here it becomes more interesting -> in the lower narrow section of the canyon there are beautiful washed-out corridors and pools with small steps that have to be rappelled or downclimbed -> unfortunately, tree trunks, some of which form large lice infestations, are always a nuisance here -> most of the anchors are well attached and have often been renewed due to several floods -> if there is a risk of thunderstorms, the canyon should definitely be avoided --> the best time to walk is between 10 a.m. and 12 noon.		
Retour: (traduction alternative) After the last bottleneck, either climb up on the right via a small path to the hiking trail or on the left before the Rositten bridge at 460 m altitude --> then return the last few meters to the parking lot.
