<b>Matériel:</b> Cordes: 2x 30m		
<b>Résumé:</b> (traduction alternative) The canyon is divided into 3 parts, between which there are long running sections on the adjacent hiking trail. Nice jumps and some rappels in the first and third parts.		
<b>Hydrologie:</b> (traduction alternative) Relatively high water flow in spring after the snow melts. Hardly any water flow towards the exit of July/beginning of August. Almost no flowing water at the exit of August.		
<b>Accès:</b> (traduction alternative) Main road into Kleinwalsertal. In Riezlern, cross the bridge and turn right towards Ifenbahn/Schwarzwassertal. Drive uphill for about 150 m, then turn right to the sports field. The road goes downhill again. Park at the sports field.		
<b>Approche:</b> (traduction alternative) Follow the hiking trail along the stream until you reach the road. Entry here for the upper part. Entry to the lower section: walk about 1 km along the hiking trail on the orographic\left side of the stream until the stream cuts in again.		
<b>Tour:</b> (traduction alternative) 2 parts are above the parking lot, the last part about 1 km below the parking lot. You normally get out after the natural bridge. However, if there is little water, 2 abseils can be made after the confluence. (Not particularly rewarding).  Entry via 5m rappel over the bridge. Otherwise you can downclimb to the right. This is followed by a via ferrata to the first rappel, which can usually also be jumped (S7 or C8). This is followed by the highest rappel of the tour, again starting with a rope traverse. This is followed by several possible jumps and smaller rappels, which can also be bypassed via the parallel hiking trail. Be sure to check the pools, especially at the exit!  The C20 final abseil follows at the exit of the second part. You can then follow the hiking trail and return to the ascent route and the parking lot.		
<b>Retour:</b> (traduction alternative) Follow the hiking trail on the orographic left back to the car

There's a lot of metal in the canyon, so it's more than well-secured. At least 2-3 chain anchors per rappel section. Water is still flowing at the moment. The pools have a high depth. All the jumps are still doable. I think there won't be any running water left in the next few weeks. Still, it's a very beautiful canyon. If you want to save yourself a 25-minute ascent, you can also drive a car directly to the entry and park there on the gravel shoulder. There should be room for 3-4 cars. (traduction alternative)

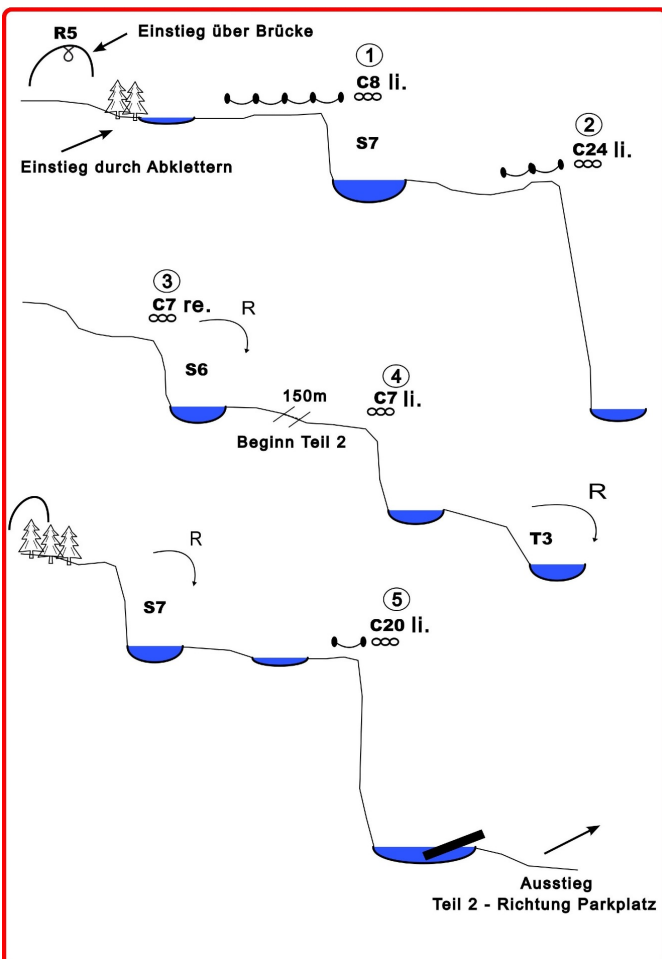
Ascent at very low water level. Rappels were mostly dry, as the waterfalls dripped rather than flowed. Jumps are mostly possible. In part two, which crosses the ascent route, there was minimal ground contact when jumping. Still easy to walk on. Anchors were easily accessible and intact. (traduction alternative)
