Also known as Monja 2 ravine, parallel to La Monja or Barrete ravine. They share access with Ajoque with a less spectacular development except for its final jump over the road. Obligatory combination of cars and replacement material, some headwaters may be in poor condition. Avoid rainy periods.

Part is within the Special Protection Zone for Birds (ZEPA) and the Teno Park, possible restrictions should be consulted in the council.

Hydrologie:

Accès: (traduction alternative)

Location of Ajoque, Marrubio, Torre and Baranda banks.

Same accesses as Ajoque:

By the road to Buenavista del Norte, with the return car we will continue towards the lighthouse / Punta de Teno by the TF445. In the p.k. 2,5 there is a deposit on the left side of the road and a place to park, it is the control point of the access to the lighthouse. From here there is a PR to the Risco. Here we leave the return vehicle.

With the access vehicle we return to Buenavista, we leave by the road to El Palmar TF436, just past El Palmar we take the detour to the right to Teno Alto. We will go to Teno where we will turn right onto the track La Mulata, we will continue along it until a fork that on the left is followed by the road La Mulata, we will go to the end where we park.

Approche: (traduction alternative)

Access bcos Ajoque, Barrete and Lajas

We will leave to the left to take a track a few meters below (about 100m) we will follow it northward for more than half a kilometer to some ruins that we will pass on the right, here we can already sense our ravine that is on the right, we will go down gradually to the riverbed in N direction.

A first part of the route is more steep to reach the great vertical above the road.

We leave by the road, we will have to walk along it to the right until we reach the parking lot of the first vehicle.

Bring headlamps to pass the tunnels and a reflective vest.
