Résumé: (traduction alternative) Short, beautiful tour; clean, cold water; short access; however, not to be underestimated at high water levels (meltwater); limestone (Untersberg marble).		
Hydrologie: (traduction alternative) Water drains away quickly after heavy rain.		
Accès: (traduction alternative) From Sbg. Süd you drive straight on the B305 in the direction of Berchtesgaden (D) --> approx. 500m after the border (St.Leonhard) there is a small bridge (traffic sign 24t) --> immediately after the bridge you have a small 90° entrance with parking in the forest.		
Approche: (traduction alternative) Over the stream or from the road, take the wide hiking trail (Kienbergsteig) which leads up into the forest on the right (orographic left next to the traffic sign 24t)--> after a few meters you come to a small forest clearing with a fork in the path, here follow the now narrower steep path to the left --> after a short distance you come to the next small fork in the path --> here follow the clearly visible path on the left without much difference in altitude above the canyon towards the stream. This is where the interesting part of the canyon begins at approx. 600m (if you follow the Kienbergsteig, you could also enter the stream further up, but it is less interesting as it takes approx. 40 minutes to walk/downclimb).		
Tour: (traduction alternative) The rather open Weißbach canyon has two approx. 25m high and several small downclimbs --> depending on the water level, the small steps can often also be climbed down --> at normal water levels, the well-equipped canyon is also suitable for beginners --> between the steps (downclimbs) there are short walking passages and small slides with washouts --> after the last approx. 8m downclimb it becomes flat --> there follows an approx. 10min walking passage in the flat canyon bed to the starting point (approx. 500m).		
Retour: (traduction alternative) From the shallow streambed, you climb right down to the parking lot.
