Sintesi: (traduzione alternativa)

Every year the access is closed from 15.September- 1. October because of Jadgwirtschaftlichen reasons; long alpine rappel canyon with about 40 rappels; predominantly single hooks (not always easy to see!); catchment area approx. 2 Km²; limestone; exposure north; some Holzverklausungen; long access and descent; mostly little water; final waterfall C65 also divisible; steep emergency exits if at all only at the beginning and possibly before C48 right possible!; absolutely take emergency equipment; hiking trail alone already worthwhile!

# Idrologia:

# **Accesso:** (traduzione alternativa)

From Salzburg Süd, take the A10 to the Salzburg junction. Then continue on the A1 towards Vienna/Linz. At the Voralpenkreuz junction, turn right at Sattledt onto the Pyhrn-Autobahn A9. Continue on this highway until the St. Pankraz/Klaus exit. Then turn left at the junction onto the B138 and continue until just before the Steyrbrücke bridge. Turn right here and continue alongside the Steyr towards Hinterstoder. Nine kilometers after the village center of Hinterstoder, at the exit of the Stodertal is the hiking parking lot / starting point (Gasthof Baumschlagerreith  $14 \, ^{\circ} \, 05'46,5 \, ^{\circ} \, 0' \, 47 \, ^{\circ} \, 38'43,2 \, ^{\circ} \, N)$ .  $4 \, \in \, / \,$  day only coin money (as of 2023)

# **Avvicinamento:** (traduzione alternativa)

From the large hiking parking lot at Almgasthof Baumschlagerreith (724m), follow the hiking signs "Stoderer Dolomitensteig" next to the stable, initially on the slightly ascending forest road to the signs "Wanderweg" in the hairpin bends. From here you leave the forest road. Follow the path over a steep embankment next to the ditch, which you cross after a short while. After the crossing there is a hiking sign with time indications (Hochsteinalm 1h15min and Lögerhütte 1h30min + Stoderer Dolomitensteig) and shortly afterwards the forest road exits. The steep ascent then begins in serpentines up through the beech forest. Once you reach the first saddle, you have already completed half of the ascent to the alpine pasture. With a beautiful view of the valley and the surrounding mountains, the trail continues up to the alpine meadow in front of the Hochsteinalm (1296m) and on to the Lögerhütte (1370m), which is already visible. Keeping left from the Lögerhütte, the actual Dolomite path begins, which in the following part leads over an increasingly narrow, steep path with little difference in altitude along steep rock faces and small water channels to the rope safety device and Schwarzgraben. Follow the rope protection in the Schwarzgraben to the point where the hiking trail crosses the stream. Entry at 1370m.

Giro: (traduzione alternativa)

The Schwarzgraben is a long beautiful alpine rappel canyon with about 40 mostly short rappels. The glued anchors are not always immediately visible due to their gray color, but they are well placed. One should not be fooled by the mostly low water passage, as the rappelling points can change considerably due to wood and gravel accumulations during high water. In the upper part, the canyon is rather open except for a short (two rappels) narrower passage. After a high 48m + small 4m rappel point and a few smaller steps that can be descended, comes a cut canyon section with initially large wooden entanglements (be careful with the rope retrival!). More small steps with some wood follow. Shortly before an hourglass as rappel anchorage it becomes more open again. Six short rappels and two walking and downclimb passages follow. After the second walking and rappeling section it remains cut for a longer time (nine rappels up to max. 20m). Before the last four abseils (5m/20m/10m/65m) the canyon opens with a view into the valley. The last rappel point can also be divided (exposed chain anchor on the right below pools after 25m). After the last high rappel, follow the streambed for about 20min over some downclimbs to the streambed and weir at the fort road (possibly rappel 5m over tree before streambed). Exit at approx. 780m at the small weir.

Ritorno: (traduzione alternativa)

From the small weir turn right on the forest road shortly back to the parking lot.


