Sintesi: (traduzione alternativa)

Short, beautiful, vertical and open lime canyon next to the Fella; old belay stations and belay slings (replace if necessary); only two steps 55m and 40m; can be combined with several canyons nearby (e.g. Livinal, Patoc, Brussine, Revis, Nero).

Idrologia:

Accesso: (traduzione alternativa)

From Tarvisio take the SS13 or the A23 freeway until the Pontebba exit. Then follow the canal valley further south. About 1,5 km after the houses of Vidali you will see a pedestrian bridge that crosses the Fella. About 100m after that, at road km 187V (right), there is a gravel parking place. Park here.

Avvicinamento: (traduzione alternativa)

From the parking lot, walk about 100m to the pedestrian bridge with the "Cadramazzo" hiking sign. Cross this and continue right on the path, past the highway parking lot to the bike path. Here you follow the trail 619 Patocco/Raccolana (on the left) steeply uphill until you reach the wayside shrine. Immediately behind the wayside shrine, you enter the stream for about 500m (wooden beams with rope traverse).

Giro: (traduzione alternativa)

The canyon begins immediately with a sharp 55m abseil. To get safely to the belay station (left), it is best to use the self-made chain anchor on the large boulder to set up a removable rope traverse. The belay consists of 2 new bolts for rappels in the water. The arrival pool is large and usually heavily covered with gravel. The second and final 40m abseil point is already waiting at the left edge of the pool. Mostly watched by onlooking cyclists, you rappel left in the water jet, alternatively right outside the water. (old belaystation on the right!). Exit at approx. 400m.

Ritorno: (traduzione alternativa)

The last meters/steps to the Fella are downclimbed. Once you reach the Fella, look for a suitable place to cross the river. It is best to aim for the bridge over the stream that flows into it a little further down. Climb up here briefly and follow the disused road back to the parking lot at road kilometer 187V.

Slightly higher water level. Short, crisp canyon, which is easily visible from the road and has two nice abseiling points. (Rappel 2 is less than 40 m) The route to the second belay is also via a pull-off rope traverse over a belay with 2 bolts and old slings. (traduzione alternativa)

After about 15m there is an old intermediate belay on two anchors, but it already looks pretty broken.
