Sintesi: (traduzione alternativa)

There are two possible starting points, followed by a series of short rappels, often from trees and not always secured with carabiners. The two canyons walk together, and the rappels become slightly longer and more exposed, eventually leading to the large, 160-meter-long rappel.

Idrologia: (traduzione alternativa)

You shouldn't hike this route too late in the season, as it loses some of its appeal otherwise. It's best to go after a period of rain... but watch out for high water!

There are almost no swimming passages, but there are wet rappelling sections (depending on the season!).

Accesso: (traduzione alternativa)

Downstream: In St. Denis, follow the road along the river of the same name until the exit occurs. Cross a very narrow pedestrian bridge and a river rapids. Park near the basketball court.

Upstream: Follow the D42 toward Bellepierre until you reach the "Les Topazes" residential complex. After house number 194, walk up the steep Allée des Fluorines. On the right, you'll quickly reach the hiking trail leading to the Bassin du Diable.

Avvicinamento: (traduzione alternativa)

Follow the trail for about 50 minutes. Shortly after Titicaca, the trail crosses a canyon via a water pipe elevated on stilts. This is the Jamrose Canyon and the "tétard" entrance; the next one is the Longose Canyon and the "tétôt" entrance.

The trail has not been maintained by the ONF for several years. It is increasingly overgrown with vegetation.

Giro: (traduzione alternativa)

See the "Ric à Ric" topographic view.

There are two possible entry points with a series of short rappels, often from trees and not always secured with carabiners. The two canyons converge, and the rappels become slightly longer and more exposed, eventually leading to the large, 160-meter-long rappel exit.

The safety precautions may seem minimal, but several teams have already been caught off guard by flash floods (see the "La Réunion" forum). However, there are numerous ways to get to safety.

Automatisch importiert von Descente-Canyon.com für Canyon Jamrose et Longose Marche d'approche un peu glissante mais bien tracée. Passage par ravine jamrose: R4 cordes et maillon un peu fatigués mériteraient d'être changés mais pour une 9m ça passe encore. Passage ensuite par le droit de droite R8 surélevé: effectivement très en hauteur, attention pour les petites tailles ! Et chaîne autour d'un arbre qui inspire moyennement confiance, mais ça tient aussi! R9: très excentré en rive droite, l'accès peut être un peu compliqué malgré les mains courantes fixes en place Pour R10: une main courante en RG est annoncé, on l'a pas trouvé (pas trop cherché non plus), le relais est accessible avec une approche prudente. R11: un point bouge malgré le serrage R13: l'ancien relais n'est plus là, remplacé par un départ de main courante permettant de rejoindre le relais 2-3m plus bas, le barreau déviateur n'étant plus utile il a été retiré R14: facilement trouvable en s'aidant des 2 plaquettes reliées par une corde dans l'axe de la descente qui sert de point de repère, nettoyage de la végétation autour du relais. R15-R16: plutôt évidants, bien suivre l'axe de la cascade, les relais sont visibles environ 2-3m avant d'arriver dessus. Pas mal de frottements sur le grand cassé final Et pas mal d'éboulis dans l'etrotiture après la 3x30m qui donne pas envie de s'attarder ! Première partie du canyon sec et vasques croupies, Puis un filet d'eau à partir de la confluence et des vasques clairs! La vue en haut du grand cassé est assez exceptionnel, très belle descente (Quelle: <https://www.descente-canyon.com/canyoning/canyon-debit/22680/observations.html>)
