Sintesi: (traduzione alternativa) A beautiful, short, entertaining lime canyon with several small steps for rappelling, jumping, and sliding; parts of it are quite narrow; stunning surroundings		
Idrologia:		
Accesso: (traduzione alternativa) From Side to the beautiful "Oymapinar Reservoir" (Turkish: Oymapinar-Baraji) in the Taurus Mountains. After passing through the tunnel and the tourist parking lot at the reservoir, follow the mountain road to the right as it continues uphill. This road leads (in about 20 minutes) far above the reservoir to the village of Kepezbeleni. (You can already see the village on the other side as you approach from above the lake.) Drive through the village until you reach the last two houses. Park here in front of the only tree on the right. (Parking exit)		
Avvicinamento: (traduzione alternativa) You can either drive the second car from the parking exit along the road for about 2 km to the parking entry, or you can walk (which takes about 45 minutes instead of 15 minutes!). First, follow the road back through the village and then turn left at the fork. After that, follow the road up the mountainside to the summit. Here, at a passing place on the left, is the possible parking entry. From here, follow the clearly visible forest trail to the left for about 15 minutes down to the streambed. Once at the bottom, continue briefly along the flat streambed until you reach the first narrow section/entry.		
Giro: (traduzione alternativa) The first narrow section also marks the start of the tour. Here, there is an anchor on the upper right side of the rock (rock in the pool!). This is followed by a walking and downclimb section with possible jumps before reaching the highest (approx. 17 m) rappelling point. After that, the canyon narrows progressively. Several beautiful washouts and small rappelling spots (some of which may be jumpable) follow, along with short swimming sections. After the last narrow crevice—which includes a swimming section—the short, impressive canyon suddenly opens up, and you find yourself surrounded by greenery.		
Ritorno: (traduzione alternativa) Continue along the streambed for about 100 meters until, after passing a tributary on the left (usually dry), you find a suitable spot to climb up to the forest road. Then follow the forest road more or less as it goes (shortcuts are possible) until you reach the parking exit.
