Sintesi: (traduzione alternativa) A scenic canyon that is little known. Although this canyon is not the pearl of the region, it is not to be sneezed at.		
Idrologia:		
Accesso: (traduzione alternativa) From Aosta, drive in the direction of the Col du Grand St Bernard. After a few kilometers, turn right towards Valpelline. At the crossroads at the exit of Valpelline, go straight on towards Oyace (left: direction Ollomont). 150 m after this crossroads, turn left to reach Semon. It is best to park next to the church in the middle of the village.		
Avvicinamento: (traduzione alternativa) From the church, take the road that leads uphill in a northerly direction. The road quickly becomes a path and then a trail. You can clearly see the last waterfall on the right. After the last field, the path turns left. At the first fork, turn right and begin the ascent in switchbacks to the canyon. At the top, the path is flat and straight across the canyon. After a sheep farm ("Chez la Ville"), turn right at the first crossroads. You quickly reach the canyon at the first hollow (where you can see an abandoned metal pipe on the ground). It is probably shorter to reach the canyon earlier. However, we have not tested this.
